MBA 2 YEAR FULL TIME

ABOUT THE COURSE

The two year full-time Master of Business Administration is one of the Flagship Programmes of NERIM Group of Institutions. Since its inception in 1999, NERIM has the distinction of producing end numbers of future managers and entrepreneurs who have proven their competence with time. With its dedicated Placement team NERIM has successfully deputed its students in companies and organization of national and global command. The Master of Business Administration (MBA 2 Year full time) course has been designed to meet the present and future needs for professional managers. The goal of the course is to create a team of competent managers and entrepreneurs to take care of the expanding business and industrial activities in the competitive environment.

OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMME

The Master programme in Business Administration (MBA 2 Year full time) aims at imparting professional education and training in modern management techniques for handling business operations in a highly dynamic and competitive environment. The programme is intended to have the following objectives.

- 1) Developing the ability to recognize and analyze problems.
- 2) Developing an analytical, decision making and problem solving skills.
- 3) Provide insight into the fundamental nature and process of management and human behaviour within the organization.
- 4) Developing the ability to formulate goals and to create commitment to these goals in a given organization.
- 5) Developing an insight into the various organizational problems in the context of changing technological, economical, social and political scenario.

AFFILIATION & APPROVAL

The MBA two year full time programme at NERIM College of Business Administration is conducted as per the prescribed regulations and syllabi of Dibrugarh University. The programme is also approved by the AICTE.

COURSE STRUCTURE & SYLLABUS

The MBA 2 year full time programme with dual specialization consists of four semesters of six months duration each. A student is required to opt for specializations in any two of the five groups offered in the third and fourth semester by Dibrugarh University.

PROJECT WORK / SUMMER TRAINING

A student of MBA 2 year full time programme needs to undertake two projects of two months (Major Project) and one month duration (minor project) in an industrial organization or a commercial firm in the Third Semester and Fourth Semester respectively, and submit a project report for the same. The topic and title of the project study is determined by the Institutional guide in consultation with the concerned organization and the student. Each student is required to submit a project report in triplicate to the head of the department as per the date notified by the Institution.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

Selection of candidates shall be made as per prescribed rules of Dibrugarh University. There shall be NERIM Entrance Test (NET) of 200 marks on General Awareness, Reasoning, Numerical Ability and English Language. Apart from the Written Test, there shall be Group Discussion (GD) for 50 marks & Personal Interview (PI) for 50 marks. Candidates having valid MAT score of minimum 500, or minimum 50 percentile in CAT are exempted from the NERIM Entrance Test (NET). However, such candidates shall require appearing for Group Discussion (GD) and Personal Interview (PI) for final selection.

ELIGIBILITY

As per the approved regulation of Dibrugarh University, a candidate who possesses any Bachelor degree of Dibrugarh University in 10+2+3 pattern, or from any other recognized university with at least 50% marks (45% for SC/ST) in aggregate in either pass or major subjects, is eligible to apply for admission into the MBA 2 year full time programme.

N.B.: Eligibility criteria and procedure for Admission is subject to change as and when notified from the concerned affiliating University.

REQUIREMENT OF CLASS ROOM ATTENDANCE

A student of MBA Full Time programme shall have to attend minimum 80% of total classes in each paper to be eligible to appear in End semester examinations. As student of MBA Full Time programme shall have to attend minimum 80% of total classes in each paper to be eligible to appear in End semester examinations.



EXAMINATION (As per regulations of the Dibrugarh University)

The examination comprises of three components- continuous evaluation, internal assessment and end semester examination. The pattern of the examination is as follows:

1. Examination of each paper will carry a total of 100 marks, out of which 40 marks will be awarded in internal assessment.
2. The semester end written examination of 3 hours duration will carry 60 marks in each paper.
3. The project work in the final semester will carry 100 marks in total out of which 40 marks shall be allocated for Viva-voce Examination which will be conducted by faculty members in the presence of external examiner. The remaining 60 marks will be awarded on the basis of the evaluation of the project report.
4. The minimum mark for passing each paper of the Semester Examination is 40 marks. The aggregate percentage for passing each Semester Examinations 50%.



PROMOTION TO SECOND YEAR CLASS

As per regulations of the Dibrugarh University, promotion to Second Year of MBA programme shall be open to those who have successfully cleared at least 10 papers offered for the First Year comprising semester- I and semester -II. However, such student will have to clear the remaining papers of the first year along with the second year examination.

AWARD OF DEGREE

Successful candidates shall be awarded the Degree of Master of Business Administration (MBA) by Dibrugarh University. Candidates securing 60% and above will be awarded First class and those securing 50% or more but less than 60% will be awarded Second class.

MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION MBA 3 Year Part Time

ABOUT THE COURSE

As per regulation of Dibrugarh University, the MBA (Part Time) Programme shall be of 3 years duration commencing from July every year and one academic year will complete in next year June. The first two years shall have common courses for all and there shall be three options for specialization only in the third year. Specialization will be offered in Marketing Management, Financial Management and Human Resource Management. As a part of the course curriculum, a student is required to undertake a Project Work on completion of Second year.

OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMME

The 3 Year part time MBA programme aims at developing professional expertise or experienced people in handling business operations in their day to day work industry with better excellence and productivity.

AFFILIATION & APPROVAL

The MBA three year part time programme at NERIM College of Management is conducted as per the prescribed regulations and syllabi of Dibrugarh University. The programme is also approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), MoE, Govt. of India.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

Admission Committee, NERIM College of Management shall select the candidates for the admission. There shall be an Admission Test in the form of Written Test for admission into the 1st Year of MBA Part Time programme. Written Test shall be of 200 marks and it shall consist of General Awareness, Test of Reasoning, Numerical Ability, and English Language. On the basis of performance of Written Test, a Merit List shall be prepared and priority in the admission shall be given on the basis of Merit List.

REQUIREMENT OF CLASS ROOM ATTENDANCE

A student of MBA Part Time programme shall have to attend minimum 80% of total classes in each paper to be eligible to appear in End semester examinations.



EXAMINATION (AS PER REGULATION OF THE DIBRUGARH UNIVERSITY)

- a) The examination comprises of three components-Continuous Evaluation, Internal Evaluation and Year End Examination.
- b) Each paper consists of 100 marks, 60 marks for year End Examination and 40marksfor continuous Internal Assessment.

PROMOTION TO NEXT YEAR

- * A student shall be required to secure at least 45% marks in aggregate in each Year End Examination and minimum 40% marks in each paper individually in order to pass the Year End Examination.
- * A student who fails in the aggregate although he/she passes in all the papers individually in the Year End Examination, shall have the option to appear or clear any number of papers of his/her choice as backlog in the following year's respective Year End Examination.
- * A student who fails to pass first year and second year examinations shall not be allowed to continue his/her studies in the second and third year respectively.
- * A student must pass all his/her Year-End Examination within 5 (five) years from the date of Admission.

AWARD OF DEGREE

A candidate on successful completion of the First Year Part Time MBA Course shall be awarded a 'Certificate in Business Management'; on successful completion of Part Time MBA Second Year Course, shall be awarded 'Diploma in Business Management'; on successful completion of the Third Year Course, shall be awarded 'MBA Degree' of Dibrugarh University.

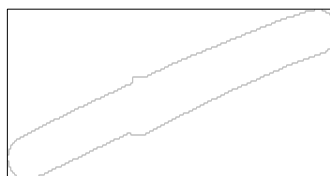

ELIGIBILITY

A student who has passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) in Arts, Science, or Commerce from the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council or any other equivalent examination recognized by the University, and has secured an aggregate of 45% marks (40% for SC/ST/OBC) with Mathematics as one of the subjects in HS, is eligible to apply for admission into the 3-Year full-time BCA programme.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The selection of candidates for admission into the 3-Year full-time BCA programme shall be done on a merit basis as determined by the University.

REQUIREMENT OF CLASSROOM ATTENDANCE

However, the following restrictions will be applicable:

The 2-Year full-time Master of Social Work (MSW) programme at NERIM College of Social Science is conducted as per the prescribed regulations and syllabus of Dibrugarh University.

COURSE STRUCTURE AND SYLLABUS

As per regulation of the Dibrugarh University, the MSW programme 2Year full time consists of four semesters of six months duration each. The first semester shall focus on the foundation course. The second semester shall focus on the functional areas. A student is required to opt for elective subject in the third and fourth semester. As per the course curriculum, the student is required to undertake a concurrent field work during the course, semester based on which the student has to submit a field work reports weekly and summary report at end of the course. Later viva is conducted on the submitted report. All the papers except Research Project in 4th Semester, has 100 marks (40 marks for Internal Assessment and 60 marks for External Assessment). The Research Project 150 marks (Report writing 100 marks & viva 50 marks)

Field Work: Field work is a distinct feature and an integral part of the total MSW degree programme. Field work enables the students to integrate and reinforce the theoretical knowledge and information acquired through classroom instruction and develop skills through actual practice under competent supervision from the agency and by the faculty supervisors. 1st and 2nd semester fieldwork placements are generic in nature. During the second year, students are placed in specialization-wise organizations for the 3rd and 4th semesters. Students are required to put in 15 hours per week in the organization in which he/she is placed for work. The fieldwork component of the MSW course is organized into concurrent fieldwork and block fieldwork. The Institute has a well-organized field work programme with a well-developed curriculum. Apart from the concurrent fieldwork, the institute organizes orientation visits in the 1st semester and a rural camp in the 2nd semester.

RESEARCHPROJECT

Every student is expected to conduct research on a selected topic and submit the research report as partial fulfillment of the requirements for the MSW degree. The faculty members guide the students in the process of conducting the research. The research project is based on the application of the theory of research methodology. Three copies of the research project are to be submitted in hard binding format at the end of the fourth semester according to the stipulated schedule.

BLOCK FIELD WORK PLACEMENT

After the End Semester Examination of the MSW course, the student is placed in an organization for a period of 30 continuous days for block field work. During this period, the student is expected to work as an intern, study all the relevant aspects of the organization, and learn to function as a full-fledged professional social worker.

As per the university rules, certification of satisfactory completion of the block placement by the organization is necessary for the declaration of the MSW result and for obtaining the MSW degree.

ELIGIBILITY

Any graduate with 45% marks in aggregate from Dibrugarh University or any other university recognized as such by the University (40% for SC/ST/OBC candidates) is eligible to apply for admission into the 2-year full-time MSW programme.

N.B.: Eligibility criteria and the procedure for admission are subject to change as and when notified by the concerned affiliating university.

REQUIREMENT OF CLASS ROOM ATTENDANCE

A student of the MSW 2-year full-time programme shall have to attend a minimum of 85% of the total classes in each paper to be eligible to appear in each End Semester Examination.

EXAMINATION SYSTEM

(AS PER DIBRUGARH UNIVERSITY REGULATIONS)

- a) To be eligible to appear in the MSW End Semester Examinations as a regular candidate, a student must attend 85% of the lectures delivered during the academic session. A student who attends at least 75% of the lectures delivered shall, however, be allowed to appear in the examination as a non-collegiate candidate on payment of a prescribed fee.
- b) The semester examinations shall be divided into two groups:
 - Odd semesters: First and Third
 - Even semesters: Second and Fourth
- c) A candidate who fails or does not appear in one or more subjects of any End Semester Examination will be provisionally promoted to the next higher semester with the failed subjects as carryover subjects. Such a candidate will be eligible to appear in the carryover subjects in the next examination of those subjects. However, the following restrictions will be applicable:
 - a) A candidate shall be allowed a maximum of 5 years to complete the MSW course. A candidate shall be entitled to a maximum of two chances (excluding the first regular examination) to clear a subject. If a candidate fails to clear a subject even after the two chances, he/she will have to repeat the semester with fresh admission.

- b) If a student clears the Fourth Semester Examination before clearing all the subjects of the previous semesters, the result of the Fourth Semester examination shall be withheld, and his/her results shall be announced only after clearing the subjects of the previous semesters.
- d) In order to pass in a subject, a candidate shall have to pass in all parts of the subject separately. A candidate who has passed all the semester examinations shall be declared to have passed the 2-Year full-time Master of Social Work (MSW) programme.



AWARDOF DEGREE

A candidate who has passed all the semester examinations shall be declared to have passed the Master of Social Work (MSW) from Dibrugarh University. Candidates securing 60% or more marks in aggregate shall be placed in the first class; candidates securing less than 60% marks in aggregate shall be placed in the second class.

ELIGIBILITY

A student who has passed the HS /10+2 Examination in Arts / Science / Commerce from any Board/ Council recognized by the University with at least 45% marks (40% for SC/ST) in aggregate, is eligible to apply for admission into the BSW 4 Year full time programme.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

Selection for Admission into four year full time BSW programme shall be made completely on the basis of Merit.

N.B.:Eligibility criteria and procedure for Admission is subject to change as and when notified from the concerned affiliating University.

REQUIREMENT OF CLASS ROOM ATTENDANCE

A student of BSW 4 Year programme shall have to attend minimum 85% of total classes in each paper to be eligible to appear in each End Semester Examinations.

EXAMINATION (AS PER REQUIREMENT OF DIBRUGARH UNIVERSITY)

There shall be six semester examinations namely Semester I, Semester II, Semester III, Semester IV, Semester V, Semester VI, Semester VII, and Semester VIII, respectively, to be conducted by the University at such dates and times as notified by the University. Each paper shall be of 100 marks out of which 80 marks will be for End Semester examination and 20 marks will be for internal assessment.

AWARD OF DEGREE

EXAMINATION SYSTEM :(As per Dibrugarh University Regulations)

- End Semester Examination

There shall be at least two in-semester assessments and one end-semester examination in each course during every semester.

- 40% of the total marks of each course shall be allotted for in-semester evaluations/internal assessment.
- There shall be one end-semester examination carrying 60% marks in each course, covering the entire syllabus of the course.
- End-semester practical examinations shall normally be held before the theory examinations.
- The end-semester examination shall be conducted as per the Dibrugarh University Examination Ordinance (amended up to date).



AWARD OF DEGREE

A candidate who has duly passed all the papers in the 2-year full-time M.A. in Applied Psychology examination shall be declared to have qualified for the award of the degree.

Apart from this, Legal Aid Camps are organized to provide legal assistance and advice to the poor and weaker sections of society in pursuit of justice.

EDUCATIONAL LOAN

A student admitted to any program at the NERIM Group of Institutions can avail of educational loans from various banks, subject to the fulfillment of the banks' terms and conditions. NERIM has signed MoUs with several nationalized banks to ensure easy access and a single-window facility for student loans.

THE PLACEMENT CELL

The Institution has a dedicated Placement Cell that provides placement assistance to students enrolled in various programs. The Placement Officer and his team act as a catalyst in facilitating, interaction between students and prospective employers by organizing both on-campus and off-campus interviews. Since its inception, more than 500 corporate houses of national and international repute have conducted recruitment drives through campus interviews.

BUS AND HOSTEL SERVICES

NERIM Group of Institutions has six separate, well-furnished hostels for boys and girls, providing homely accommodation. This includes a well-equipped girls' hostel with a capacity of 300, located within the college campus. Students who do not reside in the hostels can avail themselves of the bus service by paying a nominal fee.

GENERAL INFORMATION, RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Admission will be allowed in accordance with the rules and regulations of the concerned University.
2. Fees are to be paid for admission by the candidates, if selected, on the date as notified; otherwise, seats will be forfeited and filled by candidates next in the list.
3. The candidature of a student admitted into a Programme shall automatically stand cancelled if he/she is found to have indulged in any criminal, anti-social, or any sort of activity detrimental to academic interest/environment.
4. No student shall be admitted and allowed to pursue more than one course at a time.
5. Apart from participating in the usual academic activities prescribed in the relevant Regulations, every student is expected to participate in the co-curricular and extra-curricular activities organized by the College from time to time.
6. Class attendance is compulsory. To be eligible to sit in the examination as a regular candidate, the students should have at least 80% class attendance. However, for the MSW programme, 85% class attendance is mandatory as prescribed by the University regulations.
7. A student is required to appear in the end-semester examination due at the end of the course of studies. Students who fail to do so without assigning sufficient reasons to the satisfaction of the competent authority shall not be permitted to continue with their studies in the following year.
8. The medium of instruction and examination of all the courses shall be English.
9. Each academic session will run as per the norms prescribed by the respective University.
10. Students shall have to comply with the regulations of the course, rules, and orders as may be prescribed by the University & College authority from time to time.
11. A student who is found to violate College rules and orders shall be liable to expulsion.
12. If a student's involvement in any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, such student would be given liberty to explain, and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, that student shall be liable to expulsion from the College.
13. A student who is found to have indulged in consumption of drugs or intoxicating drinks, gambling, or other immoral activities shall be expelled from the Institute.
14. Corporate suits, study pack, and bags are provided to the admitted students of all the courses run by the institute in general. In addition to this, laptops are also provided to the students of MBA (F/T), PGDM, and MCA programmes.
15. Students who pass BBA/BCA/B.Com./BA LLB from NERIM and rank in the Top 20 in University results in their respective programme are eligible to get a scholarship for pursuing their respective postgraduate programmes at NERIM Group of Institutions.

RAGGING

Ragging in the institute is totally banned. Any violation of this rule by students will be dealt with severely. Ragging, which is a criminal and non-bailable offence, is defined in legal parlance as:

'Display of noisy, disorderly conduct or doing any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm, or raises apprehension or fear, shame, or embarrassment to a student in any academic institution. This includes teasing, abusing, playing practical jokes on, or causing hurt to such student; or asking the student to do any act or perform something which the student would not, in the ordinary course, be willing to do.'
